

Forecasting Notes & Information

Electives:

7th graders may select 1.0 credit of electives. If you choose a full-year course, write the course name in only once. Students should make their choices carefully as they will be held to their choices when school begins. Once we have finished forecasting and assigned teachers to certain classes, it is very difficult to make schedule changes. Students are choosing courses for the entire year. One-semester courses may be repeated.

Blanchet is anticipating offering the elective courses listed. **If an insufficient number of students forecast for an elective course, the course will be dropped.** In this case, or when classes are full, we will look to the alternate courses on the forecasting sheet to complete a student's schedule.

Students must list alternative choices to help ensure that they receive the best possible schedule.

Math Placement:

Teacher recommendation and/or a student's performance in Math will determine class placement.
