AWARDS & HONORS



Blanchet Catholic School is extremely blessed to have students who live each day with “Courage and Faith.” Whether it is in the classroom, on the field, or in the community, the Cavaliers challenge one another to live the mission of Blanchet Catholic School.

The Cavalier fall sports teams found much success on the court and field, but it was their success in the classroom that earned them OSAA academic honors. The OSAA Academic All-State program recognizes outstanding achievement in the classroom. The boys and girls teams in each OSAA-sanctioned activity with the highest team grade point average (G.P.A.) earns the Academic All-State Award. Members of top ten schools in each activity at each classification are also recognized with items from the year’s sponsors. Teams that earn a 3.0 G.P.A. or higher receive 25

points for their school towards the Oregonian Cup standings.

All the Blanchet Catholic fall sports teams earned a 3.0 G.P.A. or higher. Below is a list of team’s G.P.A. and how they finished in the OSAA 3A classification:

CRYSTAL APPLE NOMINEES

The Cavalier students and staff joined together at a Tuesday Time assembly on October 18 to surprise two stellar faculty members with a much deserved honor, and to thank them for making a difference in our community.

Since 1997, the Salem Area Chamber of Commerce, in collaboration with Salem-Keizer Public Schools and the Salem-Keizer Education Foundation, have recognized excellence in education. The Crystal Apple Award gives the business community the opportunity to honor area educators for making significant contributions in the lives of children. This year Blanchet is proud to announce that Mr. Bill Roberts (History Teacher) and Mr. Robin Smith (Dean of Students) were Blanchet's nominees for this prestigious honor.

WE HAVE A DOCTOR IN THE HOUSE

This past June, Blanchet science teacher Micki Halsey Randall finished her PhD., in Science Education, with an integrated minor focused on cultural and linguistic diversity degree at Oregon State University.

While working on her PhD, Micki was a graduate teaching assistant (GTA) and graduate research assistant (GRA). These positions paid for her tuition. The GTA position afforded her the opportunity to teach students in the Masters' program working toward a teaching certificate, as well as undergraduate students considering the teaching profession. Micki also designed and co-taught an online course for current teachers earning credits toward continuing education or their next degree. In all of her GTA courses, she had the fortune of co-teaching with very talented individuals. These experiences reminded Micki how valuable interactions with colleagues are, especially when designing and implementing curriculum together.

Micki's four year graduate research assistantship included assessing and evaluating a new Bioenergy program at OSU. The evaluation of the program helped the developers determine what aspects were working well and what adjustments needed to be made. Her work on the evaluation team led to presenting at conferences in Denver and Oahu. Besides presenting work at these conferences, the experiences offered opportunities for her to hear what other research is happening in education, particularly science education, and look at how she could implement new strategies into her own classroom at Blanchet. She said, "Spending time on the beach in Oahu in June wasn't bad either."

For the last five years, Micki has included inquiry investigations in Blanchet's outdoor learning environment (OLE) into the Earth Science curriculum. The students design and run their own investigations from October through March and then present their work to a panel of adults in the spring. Micki said, "I enjoy learning with the students in these investigations and decided this was the heart of what I wanted to research for my dissertation."

Micki's Blanchet class became her research

group. With permission from the students and parents, she used some of their written work and recorded conversations to analyze for evidence of considerations they make while engaging in their investigations. She wanted to know whether there was evidence from this work that indicated the students approached the learning activity from a classroom goal perspective (such as getting a good grade) or something meaningful in a broader sense. In this study, she found evidence of students shifting from classroom oriented goals early on in their investigations toward more meaningful use of their learning as the investigations progressed. In fact, in their final presentations to the adult panel, all of the conversations that were analyzed indicated students approaching their learning from the investigation in a meaningful way, not simply to reach a classroom goal. In her final analysis she said, "What struck me in this research was the need for time. My work suggests students needed time to shift their thinking - they often started with statements that indicated thinking about the grade or the teacher's expectations, but evolved into thinking bigger picture as the investigation progressed."

2016 TRUE BLUE GALA

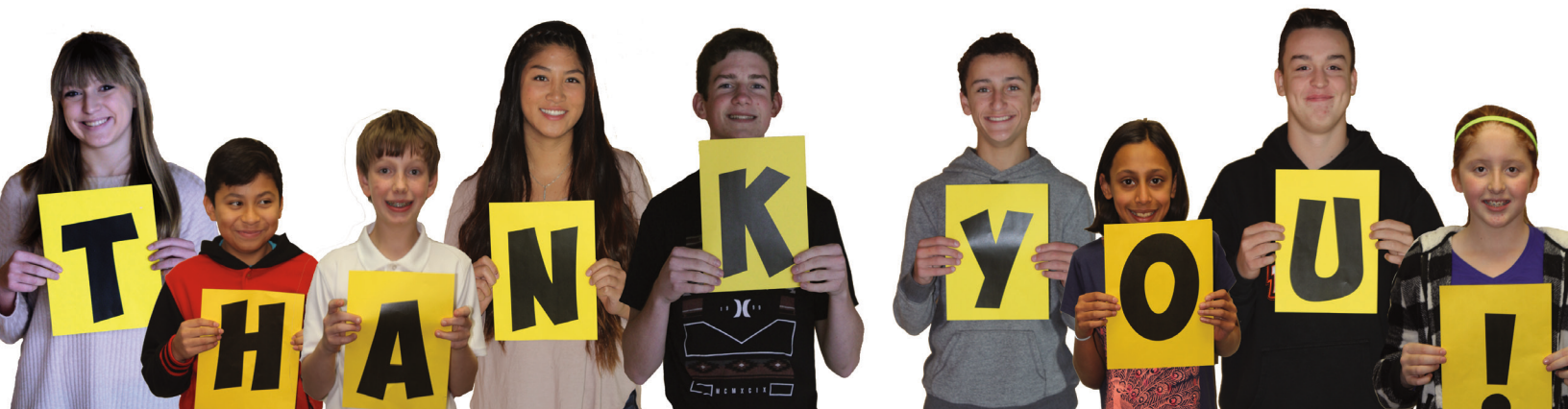

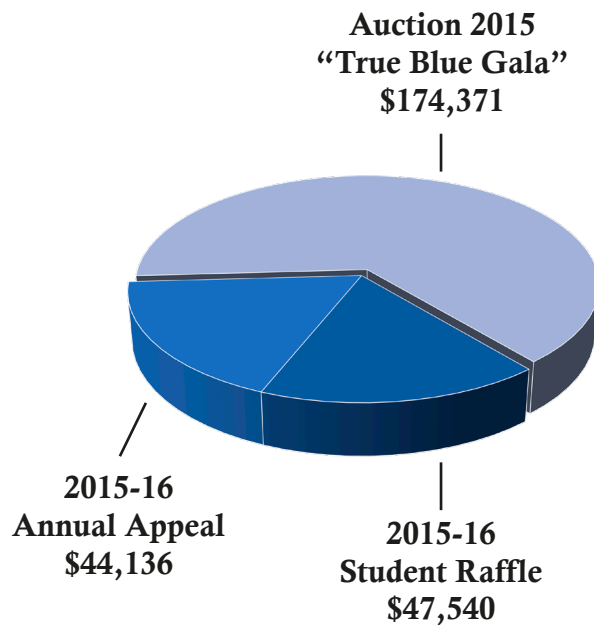

Major School Fundraisers

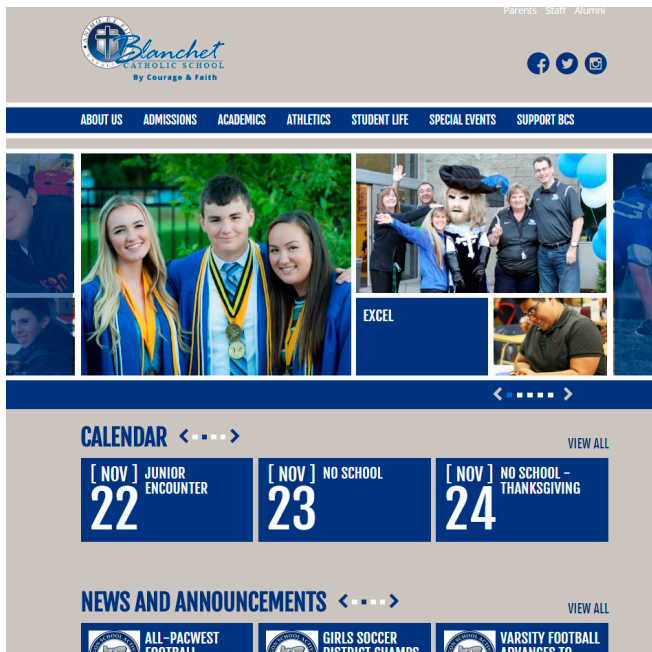
