

Forecasting Notes & Information

Electives:

Juniors may select 2.0 credits of electives. If you choose a full-year course, write the course name in only once. Students should make their choices carefully as they will be held to their choices when school begins. Once we have finished forecasting and assigned teachers to certain classes, it is very difficult to make schedule changes. Students are choosing courses for the entire year.

Blanchet is anticipating offering the elective courses listed. **If an insufficient number of students forecast for an elective course, the course may be dropped.** In this case, or when classes are full, we will look to the alternate courses on the forecasting sheet to complete a student's schedule. Students must list alternative choices to help ensure that they receive the best possible schedule.

Religion:

All high school students take a year long religion class each year.

English:

Students who wish to apply for AP English courses will ask for the application from their current English teacher.

Math & Science:

Students are required to have 3 credits of Math and Science for graduation. Teacher recommendation and a student's performance in previous Math and Science classes will determine class placement.

PE:

Students who have earned a varsity sports letter may apply for a credit waiver of this 0.5 PE credit. PE I is still a required course.

History:

Juniors may take AP U.S. History in place of U.S. History. This is a difficult college-style course that is only recommended for serious history students who have achieved at a high level in previous social studies courses. A teacher recommendation is required for this course.

Graduation Requirements:

It is important that parents and students check the graduation requirements when choosing high school courses. The Course Catalog and information regarding graduation requirements are available online at www.blanchetcatholicschool.com.

Deadlines:

Forecasting forms must be signed and turned in to the main office no later than **April 7**. Unsigned forms or forms turned in late may jeopardize a student's ability to get their first choice course selections.
