orecasting Notes & Information

Electives:

8th graders may select 1.0 credit of electives. If you choose a full-year course, write the course name in only once. Students should make their choices carefully as they will be held to their choices when school begins. Once we have finished forecasting and assigned teachers to certain classes, it is very difficult to make schedule changes. Students are choosing courses for the entire year. One-semester courses may be repeated.

Blanchet is anticipating offering the elective courses listed. If an insufficient number of students forecast for an elective course, the course may be dropped. In this case, or when classes are full, we will look to the alternate courses on the forecasting sheet to complete a student's schedule. Students must list alternative choices to help ensure that they receive the best possible schedule.

8th graders may choose to take American Sign Language I or Spanish I. These classes are high school level courses and will require a great deal of work. Students should not register for a foreign language as an 8th grader unless they are committed to doing the necessary work.

Math Placement:

Teacher recommendation and/or a student's rformance in Math will determine class placement.
