



DEVICE REQUIREMENTS

In the 2026-27 school year, high school students are required to bring a personally owned device to class. Mid-high students in grades 6 through 8 may bring their own devices but also have the option to rent a device from Blanchet.

Recommended devices include a Chromebook, Windows or Mac laptop, iPad or equivalent. Device specifications include:

- Wi-Fi capable
- Minimum 10-inch screen
- Keyboard and touchpad
- 6+ hours battery life
- Compatible with Google Suite

These devices will allow students to:

- Connect to the school Wifi for instructional purposes. Our school's internet is filtered for all users. Students with a school device have their internet filtered offsite as well.
- Provide access to Google Classroom and other software/applications used in class.
- Complete in-class assignments, work on projects/research papers, and communicate with staff.
- Blanchet Mail Accounts only have communication access with other Blanchet users.



Cell phones are NOT considered a learning device and will not be allowed in the classroom.

- Forms submitted by September 2, 2026, will have their device ready by the first day of school. Afterward, expect a turnaround of about a week to get your device checked out to you.
