SCHOLARSHIP NEWSLETTER

DEADLINES BETWEEN: October 8th & February 3rd, 2026

1) **Byte into STEM Scholarship** - \$2,500 - 3 Awards (Deadline: October 8, 2025)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be a high school senior, undergraduate, graduate student, boot camp participant, or student in a certificate program.
- B) Be planning a career in the STEM field within the United States.

2) **Regeneron Science Talent Search** - \$250,000 - 300 Awards (Deadline: November 6, 2025)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be living in and attending their last year of secondary school in the US or its territories.
- B) Accept the challenge of conducting independent science, math or engineering research.

3) **National Space Club Scholarship** - \$20,000 - 1 Award (Deadline: November 17, 2025)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be a senior in high school.
- B) Have the intention of pursuing a career in the STEM fields with a preference for those with space related interests.

4) Barbara Lotze Scholarships for Future Teachers - \$3,000 - 6 Award (Deadline: December 1, 2025)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

A) Be an undergraduate student enrolled in an accredited two-year college, four-year college or a university; or a high school senior accepted for such enrollment.

B) Be pursuing, or plan to pursue, a course of study leading toward a career in physics teaching.

5) SMART Scholarships - \$38,000 - 10 Award (Deadline: December 5, 2025)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

A) Be currently pursuing, or intend to pursue in fall 2026, a bachelor's, master's, or doctoral degree in a SMART STEM discipline.

B) Have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale.

6) AIAA Lockheed Martin Marillyn Hewson Scholarship - \$10,000 – 2 Awards (Deadline: Dec. 31, 2025)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

A) Be a high school senior intending to pursue an aerospace STEM Major in one of the following areas: Computer Engineering, Computer Science, Electrical Engineering, Industrial Engineering, Mathematics, Mechanical Engineering or Physics.

7) Science Buddy Scholarship - \$2,500 - 2 Awards (Deadline: December 31, 2025)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

A) Be entering, or currently pursuing, an educational program in the sciences.

B) Be in Grade 11 or Grade 12 and be attending college or university no later than September 15, 2026.

8) Roger W. Kahn Scholarship - \$10,000 - 4 Awards (Deadline: December 31, 2025)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be a current high school senior intending to pursue an aerospace or related major at a college or university.
- B) Have a minimum high school GPA of 3.5.

9) Healthcare Leaders Scholarship - \$1,500 - 1 Awards (Deadline: December 31, 2025)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be entering, or currently pursuing, an educational program related to nursing or medicine.
- B) Be at least 17 years old with a GPA of 3.0 or higher.

10) RevPart STEM Scholarship - \$2,000 - 3 Awards (Deadline: December 31, 2025)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be planning or currently pursuing a career in a STEM field.
- B) Be planning to attend a college in the United States.

11) Caroline E. Holt Nursing Scholarship - \$2,500 - 1 Awards (Deadline: January 31, 2026)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Have been accepted or is currently enrolled in an accredited school of nursing.
- B) Be a high school senior or undergraduate student.

12) Boeing Scholars Program - \$15,000 - 10 Awards (Deadline: January 15, 2026)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be enrolled as a high school senior and plan on joining a career in the aviation industry.
- B) Be interested in aeronautical science or aviation maintenance science.

13) Academy of Model Aeronautics Scholarships - \$8,000 - 6 Awards (Deadline: February 2, 2026)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be a high school senior who has demonstrated interest in the hobby of model aviation.
- B) Provide an official transcript and reference letter from a high school official.

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:
