Reflect on the actions or choices you make daily to stay true to your beliefs and/or your faith to maintain a sense of purpose and moral grounding.

Essays will be screened by members of Blanchet's administrators and forwarded to Mr. & Mrs. Milne for review and selection. The recipient will be announced at Blanchet's Class Day Awards Ceremony on June 6.
